“This is a unique wine; the result of difficult weather patterns. The immensely strong wind of La Tramontana ravages the vines, blowing them into contorted shapes. The grapes, though, seem to love the wind’s attention, ‘bring it on!’, they say.

Origen: DO Empordà, , communities of Villajuïga and Pau.

Blending: 60% Cabernet Sauvignon, 40% Merlot

Young wine: No crianza

Vintage: 2012

The harvest 2012: The harvest was very good, dry year and the grapes were fully ripped.

Tasting note:

Very intense red colour with a touch of blue notes.

On the nose, the wine shows ripeness, very ripe red fruit, with a light touch of jammy red pepper and

soft notes of black peppers and violet.

Structured and ripped tannins on the mouth and slight present acidity finishes.
